

Solution for Clue #3

All of these cartoons represent neighborhoods in San Francisco. Zippy the Pinhead is introducing the clue, which is a hint for you to use your map and take the zip codes of the neighborhoods. San Francisco zip codes are of the form 941XX, so use the XX as an alphabet index from 1 to 26.

This spells CREPEVINE ON CHURCH.
