

Solution to Travel Clue #4

Each of these Jeopardy! answers solves to the name of a song that is in the form of a question.
The five songs are:

WHO LET THE DOGS OUT?
WHATS NEW PUSSYCAT?
WHERE HAVE ALL THE FLOWERS GONE?
WHY DO FOOLS FALL IN LOVE?
HOW DO YOU TALK TO AN ANGEL?

Filling these into the blanks below and ordering the numbered letters yields NOTHING TO SELES
AND FEDERER, which is LOVE. We're not done yet, though, because we have to rephrase our
answer in the form of a question, as WHAT IS LOVE?

Note: Apparently this is a pretty blatant ripoff of an old MIT Mystery Hunt puzzle (sans Jeopardy!
theme)... which we swear we didn't know about. However, we learned that they used "Because the
asphalt would chafe" as an answer to WHY DONT WE DO IT IN THE ROAD?, which is way better
than any of the five we ended up using.
